General Regulations

The Competition will be held in accordance with the 2014 Regulations of the International Skating Union, relevant ISU Communications and the Memorandum of the Danubia Series 2015/2016.

Participation

Participation in the Competition is only open to ISU members and affiliated clubs. Entries can be made only through the respective members.

Track Conditions & Rink Dimensions

The Icerink of Graz has an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface of 30×60 meters. Protective padding covers the boards in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 5 and the respective ISU Communications. The tracks are in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 1 - 4.

Conditions of Contest

The individual competition is an All Round competition. All Final System and optional Knock out System is used as qualification procedure. The make up of races will be made according to Rule 296 3 c), 4, 5 and 6. Final points (34,21,13,8,5,3,2,1) will be awarded only in the respective Final-A considering Racing Rule 297 5 a) i).

During this Competition a Seminar for Starters will be held by the International Skating Union. The participants of this Seminar will be the Starters during the Competition. Therefore there will be different Starters for each distance and category.

Entries

Entries must be made according to Paragraph 4 of the Memorandum as follows, and done only electronically via <u>www.shorttracklive.info</u> :

Individual entries: each ISU Member and/or their Clubs has the right to enter skaters without limitation according to ISU Regulations.

Relay entries: each ISU Member and/or their Clubs has the right to enter one team per category. Relay members must have participated in the individual events.

Each skater has the right to start individually in his/her respective or next higher age category. The skater is not allowed to change the category during the whole season.

Deadline of Entries and Hotel Requests 30 days before the competition: August 27, 2015:

By this deadline it is required to submit:

- Name of Skaters and Team Members
- completely filled in hotel-, meal- and travel forms.

Final Entry: Changes and updates of the submitted data are possible until September 20, 2015.

Entry Fee:

Entry fee: 15 EUR p.p. per entered skater (based on the Final Entry) – even the entered skater is not participating.

Deposit for helmet covers 10 EUR p.p., which will be refunded at the end of the competition on returning the cover.

Awards

Medals will be awarded to the first three competitors in the individual event. Recognitions will be awarded to the first three relay teams.







Citizenship / Residence Requirements and Clearance Procedure

In accordance with Rule 109 of ISU Regulations and the current ISU communication, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

Liability and Medical Insurance

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, the Austrian Speed Skating Association and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the competition. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance (medical and accident) coverage for their athletes.

Accommodation and Meals

All meals and lodging expenses are the sole responsibility of the participating members and must be paid directly upon arrival. The organizing committee will cover accommodation expenses of only Junior Skaters for following ISU Members : AUT, BUL, CRO, CZE, HUN, LAT, POL, ROU and SVK – according to the agreed cross-hosting cooperation in the official hotel based on **double and triple bed basis** (Standard Rooms).

The Organizing Committee will offer accommodation with full board for team members (athletes and team officials) only in the official hotel at the following special price:

132 EUR per person / 3 nights* (3 nights, full board: breakfast, lunch, dinner - international food, free wifi), starting on Thursday with dinner and ending with lunch on Sunday on **double and triple bed basis** (Standard Rooms).

Single room supplement: 60 Euros / 3 nights

Hotel Garage available: 8 Euro per day / car.

* This special price is based on following conditions:

- as long as rooms are available (first come, first serve basis)
- optimized breakdown of rooms by the organizer based on one, two, and three people sharing
- Lunch will be served in the icerink.
- **reservation must be made until August 27, 2015** (after this date, the rest of the rooms will go back to the hotel reservation system and the rooms are then only available at standard price).

Reservation for the official hotel are only possible through the Organizing Committee and must be made by filling in the electronic hotel request form – absolut deadline is **August 27, 2015**.

Extra lunches can be ordered with the entry by the organizing commitee: **8,00 EUR** per person per lunch and must be paid upon arrival to the organizer via cash.
