# Junior Challenge Series 2018-19 In Short-Track Speed Skating

#### November 23-25 Sanok Poland

The Polish Speed Skating Association has the honour to invite you to participate in the 1 st Junior Challenge Series competition for season 2018/19 under the following conditions:

#### **GENERAL RULES**

The Competition will be held in accordance with the 2018 Regulations of the International Skating Union, relevant ISU Communications and the Memorandum of the European Competition Series 2018/2019.

#### **PARTICIPATION**

Only registered competitors of the ISU Member are allowed to participate.

#### AGE GROUPS

<u>Ladies/Men above 19 (revised)</u> Junior A 17 and 18 Junior B 15 and 16

Junior C 13 and 14 Junior D 10, 11 and 12;

Junior E 9 and younger

Age before July the 1st preceding the Competition:

Skaters of the Category C2 who fulfil the age limit requirement (14 years by 1 July preceding the season) to compete in the World Junior Championships and have the time limit for the category Junior B may participate in the category B.

#### **COMPETITION**

The competitions will be carried out in "Arena Sanok" Poland 4 Królowej Bony Str. measuring 30x60 m. The compass of the track is 111.12 m, according to ISU Rules with curves of 8m. During the competitions there will be used 5 tracks with displacement of 1m

each. The finish line for all distances is the same: only the starting place of the distances 500 and 1500 m will be changed: 1000 m and the relays will not be changed.

#### **EQUIPMENTS**

Only equipments, which are in accordance with the ISU rules, can be used in the competitions. The compulsory rounding of the corners of the blades will be controlled.

#### **ENTRIES**

Individual entries: each ISU Member has the right to enter skaters according to ISU Regulations (Rule 109). Clubs may only enter skaters through their respective Member federations.

Entries can only be made electronically through the Website: <a href="www.shorttracklive.info">www.shorttracklive.info</a>, indicating the right spelling name and date of birth.

Each skater has the right to start in the respective or next higher age category. The skater is not allowed to change the category during the whole season.

**NEW** skaters can be electronically entered by the respective federation.
