2. LOCATION: Ice Rink, Białystok ul. 11 Listopada 28

The competition will be held in the covered lce Rink with an indoor ice rink measuring 30x60 metres and traditional rink board Padding System. The compass of the track is 111.12 metres with curves of 8 metres as per the ISU Rules. There will be seven (7) tracks with a displacement of 0,7 metre each, while the finish line for all distances is the same and only the starting place of distances 500 metres and 1500 metres will be changed.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Competition will be held in accordance with the 2018 Regulations of the International Skating Union, relevant ISU Communications and the Memorandum of the Danubia Series 2019/2020.

CONDITIONS OF CONTEST

The individual competition is an All Round competition. All Final System is used as qualification procedure. The make up of races will be made according to Rule 296 and the Memorandum. Final points (34,21,13,8,5,3,2,1) will be awarded in the respective Finals considering Racing Rule 295 § 5.

PARTICIPATION

Only those competitors who have submitted their entries and paid the entry fee by the given deadline are allowed to participate.

Participation in the Competition is only open to ISU members and affiliated clubs. Entries can be made only through the respective members.

Please indicate your intention of participation as soon as possible in order to enable us to prepare the competition as well as possible.

ENTRIES

By submitting an entry the competitor clearly agrees to all terms set in this Announcement.

Preliminary Entries must reach the OC by October 27 at the latest!

The Final Entry must be electronically (www.shorttracklive.info) entered not later than November 17 and should include the following:

- the title of the competition
- the name of the Club and ISU Member making the entry
- the number of athletes in each category
- the number of coaches and team leaders
- the first (given) name and surname of the competitor(s)
- the date of birth of the competitor(s)
- the date and time of arrival and departure of the competitor(s) and those accompanying them

ENTRY FEE

The **entry fee** is 35,- EUR/person – paid only in cash

- The entry fee must be paid until the start of the Technical Meeting. Please note that helmet covers and transponders will only be handed over at the Technical Meeting if payment is fulfilled!
- the deposit for helmet covers and transponders is 50,- EUR/team

PAYMENT:

ALL EXPENSES CONCERNING MUST BE PAYED BY CASH AT THE AT THE ACCREDITATION. NO CREDIT CARDS !!!

EQUIPMENT:

Only that equipment which are in accordance with the ISU Rules can be used in the competitions; this will be checked in the Heat Box before the competitors enter the ice

- compulsory rounding of the corners of the blades
- helmet
- cut proof Glover

AWARDS:

The first three placed competitors of each distance and category receive a medal immediately after the respective final on ice, while the individual all-round competition, and the first three placed relayteams in each category will be awarded with medals respectively at the end of the competition.

ACCOMMODATION:

All meals and lodging expenses are to be paid by the participating members. The OC recommends hotel near Ice Rink (1,5 km), listed below, the below rates are available in limited numbers and Orly guaranteed until 27 October 2019. Reservations should be made through the Organizing Committee.
