2. Location:

The competition will be held in the covered Ice Hall of Jászberény with an indoor ice rink measuring 30x60 metres and a protective padding system in accordance with Rule 208, paragraph 5 and the respective ISU Communications. The tracks are in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 1 – 4. The compass of the track is 111.12 m, according to ISU Rules with curves of 8 m. During the competitions there will be 7 additional tracks with displacement of 0,7 m each, while the finish line for all distances is the same and only the starting place of distances 500 metres and 1500 metres will be changed.

6. Guiding rules:

The competition will be carried out according to the International Skating Union's (ISU) General Regulations 2018.

7. Participation:

- only registered competitors of ISU Members are allowed to participate
- only those competitors who have submitted their entries and paid the entry fee by the given deadline are allowed to participate

Please indicate your intention of participation as soon as possible in order to enable us to prepare the competition as well as possible.

- **8. Entries:** by submitting an entry the competitor clearly agrees to all terms set in this Announcement.
 - the Preliminary Entries should be communicated to the Organizing Committee until January 28, 2020 at the latest and contain the following data:
 - o the title of the competition
 - o the name of the Club and ISU Member making the entry
 - the number of athletes in each category
 - o the number of coaches and team leaders
 - the financial statement of the respective Club/ISU Member that all occurring costs will be covered by them
 - the Final Entries shall be communicated to the OC and submitted electronically via the www.shorttracklive.info website not later than February 09, 2020 and must clearly state:
 - o the first (given) name and surname of the competitor(s)
 - date of birth of the competitor(s)
 - data requested for drawing purposes
 - o the date and time of arrival and departure of the competitor(s) and those accompanying them
 - the financial statement of the respective Club/ISU Member that all occurring costs will be covered by them
 - the **entry fee** is 20,- EUR/person

The entry fee must be paid in cash at the Technical Meeting (February 14). Please note that helmet covers and transponders will only be handed over if payment is fulfilled!

- the **deposit** for helmet covers and transponders is 50,- EUR/team
- cancellation is only accepted in case of an injury or illness strictly supported by medical certificate, in which case the amount of entry fee will be refunded

- **9. Equipment:** only that equipment which are in accordance with the ISU Rules can be used in the competitions; this will be checked in the Heat Box before the competitors enter the ice
 - compulsory rounding of the corners of the blades
 - helmet
 - gloves (cut proof gloves are strongly advised)

10. Awards:

The first three placed competitors of the individual all-round competition will receive medals and a diploma, while the first three placed relay teams in each category will be awarded with medals respectively at the end of the competition.

The ultimate standing will be calculated by adding the final points 34-21-13-8-5-3-2-1 scored in the Finals. In case of a tie, the points are determined by combining the points of the positions involved and equally distributing to the respective participants. (See ISU Rule 295.§ 5.)

11. Accommodation: all lodging expenses are to be paid by the participating members.
