#### **GENERAL RULES**

The competition will be held in accordance with actual ISU Short Track Speed Skating Regulations.

#### **PARTICIPATION**

Only registered competitors of the ISU Member are allowed to participate. The competition is completely open for all ISU Members.

#### **AGE GROUPS**

- In the series the following Categories are applied, for both Women and Men, as specified in Rule 108 of the ISU General Regulations.
   Junior C Age 13 and 14
   Junior D Age 11 and 12
- Age before July the 1st preceding the Competition
- Entries can only be accepted if a skater is entered into the correct age category according to their date of birth.

#### **COMPETITION**

The competitions will be carried out in "Town Ice Rink" Spartakovská 7239/1B, 917 01 Trnava, measuring 30x60 m. The compass of the track is 111.12 m, according to ISU Rules with curves of 8 m. During the competitions there will be used 7 tracks with displacement of 0,7 m each. The finish line for all distances is the same: only the starting place of the distances 500 and 1500 m will be changed: 1000 m and the relays will not be changed.

#### **EQUIPMENTS**

Only equipment's, which are in accordance with the ISU rules, can be used in the competitions. The compulsory rounding of the corners of the blades will be controlled.

#### **ENTRIES**

Individual entries: each ISU Member has the right to enter skaters according to ISU Regulations (Rule 109). Clubs may only enter skaters through their respective Member federations.

Entries can only be made electronically through the Website: <a href="https://www.shorttracklive.info">www.shorttracklive.info</a>, indicating the right spelling name and date of birth.

Each skater has the right to start in the respective or next higher age category. The skater is not allowed to change the category during the whole season.

NEW skaters can be electronically entered by the respective federation.

#### **ENTRY FEE:**

EUR 60 € skater FOR SKATERS OUT OF DANUBIA: EUR 40 € skater

The **Final entries** must be electronically entered not later than **December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025.** The number of participating teams for relays will be determined during team leaders meeting depending on the number of applications.

Deposit for helmet cover is 20 € / Team, which will be refunded at the end of the competition on returning the helmet cover.

#### **AWARDS**

The first three-placed competitors of the individual competition in the distance ranking will receive medals accordingly.

The skaters of the first three-placed relay teams of each category will be awarded with medals respectively.

#### **RESULTS**

All results of the competition series will be published on the website www.shorttracklive.info

#### **LIABILITY**

Each competitor participates in the competition at his/her own risk and assurance. The competition is completely open for all ISU Members.
