#### **General Rules and Regulations**

Indonesia National Ice Skating Championships 2026 – Short Track Speed Skating will be conducted under the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules 2024, policies and procedures of Indonesia Ice Skating Federation (FISI). These will apply in conjunction with the International Skating Union (ISU) competition rules where applicable and appropriate.

The Indonesia National Short Track Championship 2026 will be held on **30 April 2026** and is conducted as an Open International Competition, welcoming participation from both Indonesian and international skaters.

#### **Technical Equipment**

Skaters must have and use all safety equipment.

Knee and shin pads, neck guards, body suits, safety helmets and gloves are compulsory equipment for all competitors in the Short Track events and must be worn appropriately. Only equipment which are in accordance with the ISU rules can be used in the Championships.

Skates used in the Short Track events must be short track blades conforming to ISU regulations with tubes closed, and compulsory rounding of the corners of the blades with the blade ends rounded off with a minimum radius of 10mm.

#### **Transponder and Helmet Cover Usage & Deposit Policy**

Each skater will be assigned a transponder & helmet cover for the duration of the competition. Please take note of the following:

Cost per transponder is USD 100.

Teams are responsible for the safe return of all transponders in good condition. Any loss or damage will incur a replacement fee of USD 100 per unit.

Each team is required to submit a refundable deposit of USD 100 before the competition. The deposit will be returned in full at the end of the event upon return of all transponders in proper condition.

#### **Eligibility and Requirements**

All skaters must be registered by the closing deadline. All FISI members are invited to participate.

Skaters who are participating in the Short Track events must be registered as current members of FISI. Skaters who are not Indonesia Citizens or Indonesia Permanent Residents may compete as guest skaters in the Short Track events.

Skaters must also supply the following documents with their official entry form:

- **For Indonesia Citizen** – A certified true copy of the skater's birth certificate or passport. Skaters whose training location is not in Indonesia must also complete FISI Notice and Declaration Form.
- **For Indonesia Permanent Resident** – A certified true copy of the skater's Indonesia permanent residence permit, passport and official clearance certification from his/her country of citizenship.
- **For Guest Skater** – Entry form must be endorsed by the association of the country of his/her country of citizenship. Guest skaters who are unable to obtain such endorsement because he/she does not belong to any skating association in the country of his/her citizenship must complete the form in FISI Notice and Declaration Form.

## **Divisions & Distances**

The age of the skater shall be that age the competitor is before 1 July 2025. Age Divisions for Ladies and Men:

Individual events will be run for both Women and Men in the different divisions. The combining of divisions, and changes of distance in the event if insufficient entries are received, is at the discretion of the competition organizers and officials to ensure a smooth and efficient competition schedule. The competition organizing committee will advise participants of any of the above alterations are required. Detailed event schedule will be announced at a later date. If the number of entries for the Relay division is not sufficient, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel this event.

## **Competition Format**

The competition will be using the heats/final system. Heat races are only performed when the final race could not be conducted in a single race.

## **Seeding of starting position**

Skaters will be seeded randomly for starting position of each heats race, the outcome from the heats will determine the seeding for the final. In the case where there is no heats race needed, the skaters will be seeded randomly for the final race.

## **Awards**

Medals are awarded to the top 3 skaters per event (i.e. per category and distance)

- Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be presented to the champion, second and third placed competitors respectively.
- Guest skaters will be awarded separately than the Indonesian medalists
- The title of National Champion can only be held by an Indonesia Citizen or an Indonesia permanent resident who has obtained an official clearance certification from his/her country of citizenship and compete in non-open or non-basic categories.

## Entries

All competitors must be entered through their respective FISU Pengprov / ISU Member Federation.

The above entry fees are regardless of participating in one, two or all distances per division. **The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.**

After the Final Entry deadline **Monday, 30 March 2026 at 18:00 (GMT+7), Jakarta time** the respective FISU Pengprov / ISU Member Federations will receive an invoice for the entry fee(s).

The entry fee(s) shall be paid within three (3) days after receipt of the invoice. Entries for which payment has not been received within this period shall be automatically cancelled.

## **Late entries will not be accepted**

Skaters who are non-FISU members must also supply the following supplementary documents via scanned soft copy and email to [entries@iceskatingindonesia.com](mailto:entries@iceskatingindonesia.com) after submitting your online entry form.

- Copy of the skater's birth certificate or passport
- Copy of an issued Clearance Certificate from his/her country allowing the skater to qualify for the National or National Development Team of Indonesia.

There will be no refund of entry fee for any skater who withdraws after the closing date for entries.

**Entries will not be accepted without full payment, or without the documents mentioned above.**

### **Insurance and Liability**
