ALPE ADRIA TROPHY 2015

Slovene Open Championships – Short Track Speed Skating (Celje, March 28th - 29th, 2015)

The Slovene Skating Union and Skating Club Celje are honoured to invite your team to the **Alpe Adria Trophy 2015 Final Event** and the Slovene Open Short-Track Speed Skating Championships.

The competition will be carried out at the Celje indoor ice rink ("Mestni park", Partizanska 3a, Celje, Slovenia) on a track in accordance with Rule 280, Paragraphs 1 - 4. Protective padding will be used to cover the entire rink board in accordance with Rule 280, Paragraph 5 and the respective ISU Communications.

RULES

The Competition will be held as an All-round competition in accordance with the 2014 Regulations of the International Skating Union and relevant ISU Communications. Individual races will be carried out according to the All-Final System.

The make-up of the races will be according to Rule 296, Paragraphs 3c, 4, 5 and 6. Points and classification will be awarded according to Rule 295, Paragraphs 5 - 8.

CATEGORIES

The competition will be opened to the following age groups:

Seniors	30.6.1995 and older
Juniors A	1.7.1995 – 30.6.1997
Juniors B	1.7.1997 - 30.6.1999
Juniors C	1.7.1999 – 30.6.2001
Juniors D	1.7.2001 - 30.6.2003
Juniors E	1.7.2003 - 30.6.2005
Juniors F	1.7.2005 and younger

Junior G category will be displayed on www.shorttracklive.info website only to enable online entry, however the Junior G skaters will <a href="compete and receive final classification in the Junior F category. All skaters are allowed to race in their own age category, or one category older, however must compete in the same category in all Alpe Adria competitions of the season. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to combine age groups depending on the number of final entries per group. There is also a possibility of mixed gender groups for younger categories. Final results will be calculated for each age group separately.

The organizing committee reserves the right to change any aspects of the competition or limit the programme to one day based on the number of entries and due to any unforeseen circumstances.

AWARDS

In each age category <u>medals</u> will be awarded to the best three skaters in the individual overall ranking of the Alpe Adria competition in Celje.

In each age category the best three skaters in the individual overall ranking of the season (all four

competitions of the Alpe Adria Trophy series) will receive the Alpe Adria Individual Trophy 2015.

The Alpe Adria Team Trophy 2015 will be awarded to the team with the highest number of combined points from all four competitions of the Alpe Adria Trophy series. Points will be awarded to six highest ranked skaters in the Overall classification of each Alpe Adria Trophy competition in categories: Senior, Junior A, Junior B, Junior C, Junior D, Junior E, Junior F, Relay 3000m and 2000m. The highest ranked skaters will receive points in descending order: 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 and 1 point. However, only 2 best skaters from each participating club/member will receive Team Cup points. The points of subsequent skaters from the same club/member will go to the next placed skater of a different club/member. In case of a tie, the highest score in the Senior category (men and ladies) will decide the winner.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

There will be a Medical representative present at the warm up and during the competition.

EQUIPMENT

All equipment must be in line with the ISU rules. The use of compulsory safety equipment and proper rounding of the blades will be strictly monitored.

ACCOMMODATION

The expenses for accommodation and meals are at the sole responsibility of the participating teams. Please make the reservation yourself directly with the front desk of the hotel.
