ISU Junior Challenge Series 2021-22 In Short-Track Speed Skating

October 08-10 Sanok Poland

The Polish Speed Skating Association has the honour to invite you to participate in the 1 st ISU Junior Challenge Series competition for season 2021/22 under the following conditions:

GENERAL RULES

The competition will be held in accordance with actual ISU Short Track Speed Skating Regulations.

PARTICIPATION

Only registered competitors of the ISU Member are allowed to participate.

AGE GROUPS

Woman /Men

Junior A, B, C2 (competing in one joined group)

Skaters in the Category C who fulfil the age limit requirement (14 years by 1 July preceding the season) to compete in the World Junior Championships and have the time limit for the category Junior C may participate in the category B.

COMPETITION

The competitions will be carried out in "Arena Sanok" Poland 4 Królowej Bony Str. measuring 30x60 m. The compass of the track is 111.12 m, according to ISU Rules with curves of 8m. During the competitions there will be used 7 tracks with displacement of 0,7 m each. The finish line for all distances is the same: only the starting place of the distances 500 and 1500 m will be changed: 1000 m and the relays will not be changed.

EQUIPMENTS

Only equipments, which are in accordance with the ISU rules, can be used in the competitions. The compulsory rounding of the corners of the blades will be controlled.

Deposit for helmet covers and transponders is 50 EUR p. Member, which will be refunded at the end of the competition on returning the cover and transponders.

ENTRIES

Individual entries: each ISU Member has the right to enter skaters according to ISU Regulations (Rule 109). Clubs may only enter skaters through their respective Member federations.

Entries can only be made electronically through the Website: www.shorttracklive.info, indicating the right spelling name and date of birth.

NEW skaters can be electronically entered by the respective federation.

ENTRY FEE: EUR 35, - p.p. for category Senior, Junior A, B, C2 (C2 enter pls in JUN B) EUR 20, -p.p. for category Junior C,D,E,F

The fully electronically filled out <u>Preliminary Entries</u> must reach the OC by

September 20 at the latest!

These entries should contain the following dates:

- the name of Member Association or Club
- the number of the team members and the list of names (full names),
- the date of birth.

The <u>Final Entry Forms</u> must be electronically entered not later than <u>September 26 2021</u>

AWARDS

The first three-placed competitors of the individual competition in the distance ranking will receive medals accordingly.

The skaters of the first three-placed relay teams of each category will be awarded with medals respectively.

LIABILITY

Each competitor participating in the competition at his/her own risk and assurance. The competition is completely open for all ISU Members.

COVID-19

The OC reserves the right to change the date, location, and program of the competition. When submitting an entry all competitors acknowledge that due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation and public health issues the OC can only host the competition in accordance with the effective medical and government regulations and has the solemn right to cancel the competition at any time or to host it between closed doors with a limited number of competitors and no spectators. The competitors also acknowledge that in case laws forbid it the OC is unable to hold the competition. Furthermore, in case the competition cannot take place due to legal restrictions or public health issues the OC bears no responsibility for any damage resulting from the cancellation and thus no claims can be made towards the OC. The OC is not obliged to assign a new date for the competition if it is cancelled because of the abovementioned reasons. The competitors acknowledge that upon cancellation of the competition they do not have the right to claim back the already paid entry fee as the OC had various costs concerning the competition.
